Regulations of Scholarships for Students of the International Foundation Program

Jan. 8, 2005 Approved at the 9th Executive Council Meeting of 2024 Academic Year

Dec. 31, 2025 Approved at the 11st Executive Council Meeting of 2025 Academic Year

Article 1 To encourage students of the International Foundation Program at Yuan Ze University to enhance their proficiency in Chinese language and professional courses, the Regulations of Scholarships for Students of the International Foundation Program (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations") are established.

Article 2 Eligibility

The Regulations apply to students enrolled in the first semester of their first year in their department from the first semester of the 2027 academic year onwards.

Article 3 Types, Details, and Application Procedures for Scholarships:

I. Types and Details:

1. Scholarships for the International Foundation Program:

1) Students officially entering the first semester of the first year of their department who meet the following conditions are eligible for scholarships:

(1) For students who have achieved Level B2 or higher on the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) Listening and Reading Test, and who achieved score of 90 or above in Chinese courses during the International Foundation Program study period will be awarded a 50% tuition and miscellaneous fees scholarship.

(2) For students who have achieved Level B1 on the TOCFL Listening and Reading Test, and who have achieved score of 90 or above in the Chinese courses during the International Foundation Program study period will be awarded a 20% tuition and miscellaneous fees scholarship.

2) Scholarship for students officially entering the second semester of the first year in their department will be processed in accordance with the "Yuan Ze University Regulations of Scholarships for International Students" and the "Yuan Ze University Regulations of Scholarships for Overseas Chinese Students".

2. Chinese Language Proficiency Test Scholarships for the International Foundation Program:

1) Students who, during their first year in the department, participate in the TOCFL Listening and Reading Test and achieve scores higher than those attained at the end of their studies in the International Foundation Program may apply for a scholarship of TWD 2,000.

2) Each student may apply for this scholarship only once.

II. Application Procedures:

1. Scholarships for the International Foundation Program:

- 1) Students officially entering the first semester of the first year in the department must submit the scholarship application form to the Global Affairs Office at the beginning of the semester. The application will be reviewed and approved by the Global Affairs Office.
 - 2) Starting from the second semester of the first year, scholarship applications will follow the "Yuan Ze University Regulations of Scholarships for International Students" and the "Yuan Ze University Regulations of Scholarships for Overseas Chinese Students".
2. Chinese Language Proficiency Test Scholarships for the International Foundation Program: Eligible students must submit relevant TOCFL certification documents to the International Foundation Program in the Global Affairs Office within 15 days from the start of the first semester of their second year. Late submissions will be considered as a waiver of the application, and no objections will be entertained.

Article 4 Any student who has been found to apply for this scholarship by using a forged instrument or false facts will be immediately disqualified from receiving this scholarship. All the scholarship paid to him/her previously shall be reimbursed to the University.

Article 5 Students enrolled at Yuan Ze are required to abide by the University's regulations. Scholarship qualifications may be revoked at any time if a violation is reported by the department (program, school, college) and approved by the Global Affairs Office.

Article 6 The Regulations herein will come into effect after approval by the Administrative Meeting. Amendments to the Regulations shall follow the same procedure.
