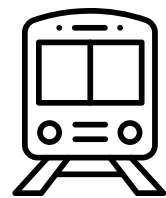

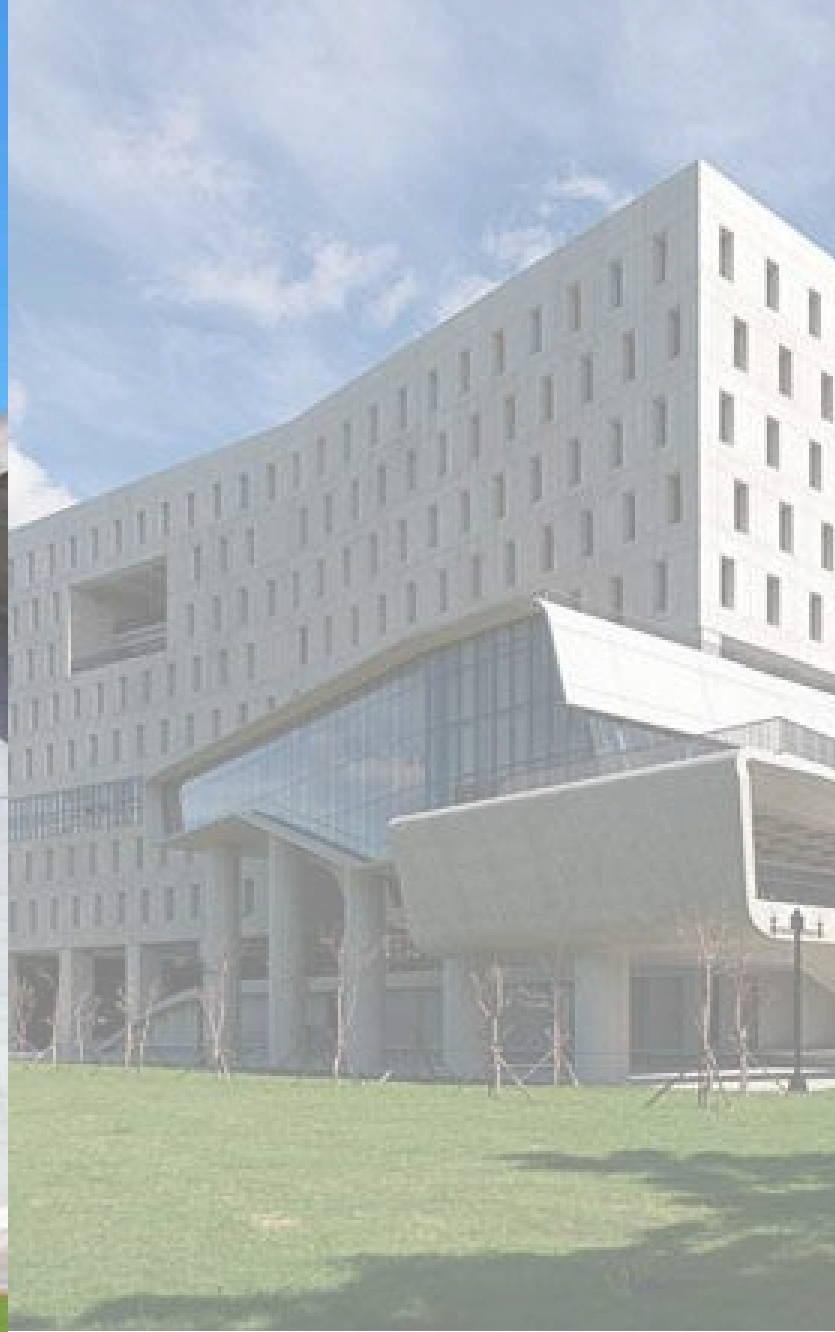

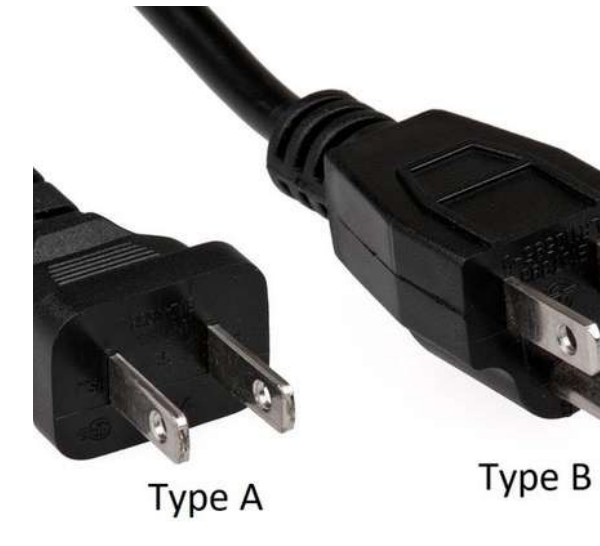

WEATHER IN TAIWAN

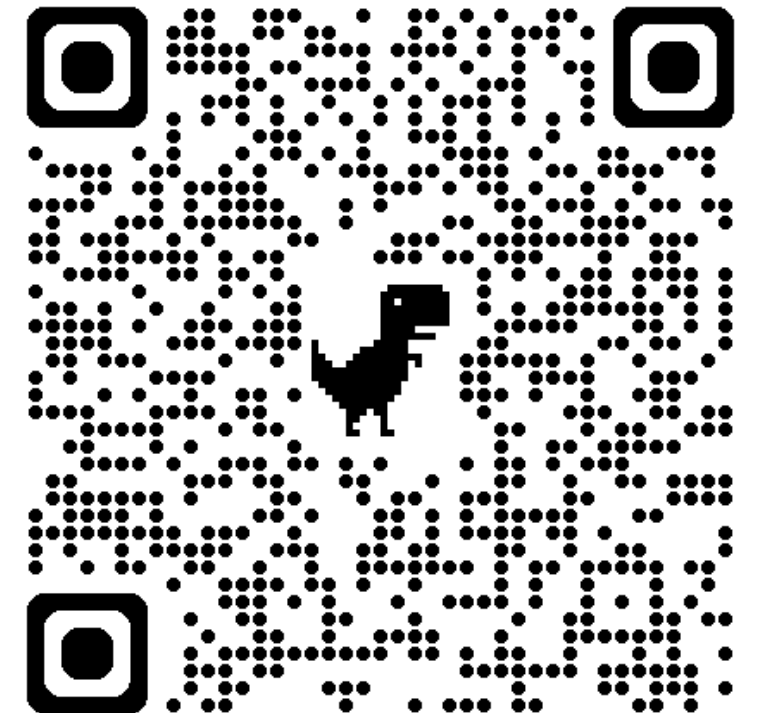



Datong Dormitory Family dormitory	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each unit has 4-5 beds, totaling 28 beds. • Each bed 3000/month+ independent electricity meters shared per household. • Room types vary: 1 large room with 3 beds + 1 small room with 2 beds, living room + 2 rooms * each with 2 large beds, 1 bathroom, equipped with a basic kitchenette. Each floor has a washing machine and a drying area. • Desk, portable wardrobe, air conditioner, mattress • Graduate students are preferred; room types are arranged by St. De Christ College.
