Regulations for Chinese Proficiency Testing Scholarship for International Students

1. In order to enhance the Chinese language proficiency of international students at Yuan Ze University, the "Regulations for Chinese Proficiency Testing Scholarship for International Students" (hereinafter referred to as "these regulations") are hereby formulated.
2. Undergraduate and graduate international students of Yuan Ze University (hereinafter referred to as "the university") who achieve scores that meet the subsidy criteria in the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) during their academic studies shall be eligible for the issuance of a monetary reward as an encouragement.
3. Eligibility criteria:
 - I. International degree-seeking students who take the TOCFL examination and meet the subsidy criteria before their senior year of undergraduate studies, the first year of master's studies, or the second year of doctoral studies.
 - II. The issuance date of the score certificate must be within one year prior to the application date.
 - III. Each student is eligible to receive the subsidy once during their enrollment at the university.

4. The maximum amount of the reward for the TOCFL examination is as follows:

Passed Test Level	Maximum Amount of Reward
A2 Basic Level	NTD 1,000
B1 Intermediate Level	NTD 1,500
B2 Advanced Level	NTD 2,000
C1 Proficiency Level	NTD 2,500
C2 Mastery Level	NTD 3,000

5. Application procedures:
 1. Applicants must submit the original score certificate and student ID card to the Chinese Language Proficiency Enhancement Program coordinator in the Global Affairs Office for review before May 15th of each year. Those who pass the examination will have their applications recorded by the coordinator and forwarded to the MOE Higher Education Sprout Project coordinator in the Global Affairs Office for final review.

2. Upon approval by the MOE Higher Education Sprout Project of the Global Affairs Office, the reward will be disbursed. The amount of the reward may be adjusted based on the annual budget and the number of recipients.
3. The necessary expenses for this scholarship will be reviewed and paid under the MOE Higher Education Sprout Project. These regulations shall take effect upon approval by the meeting of the Office of Global Affairs and any amendments shall be subject to the same process.
